HOW MANY?

How many vegetables/ jackets/ teddy bears/ cows/ heads?

*There are **three** vegetables/ jackets/ teddy bears/ cows/ heads*

MATCH BY COLOUR

*What is **pink** and **blue**? It's a **jacket***

*What is **green** and **black**? It's a **jumper***

*What is **green** and **yellow**? It's a **hat***

*What is **grey** and **red**? They are **boots***

What is **white** and **brown**? It's a **scarf**

What is **orange** and **blue**? They are **socks**

What is **purple** and **orange**? They are **trousers**

What is **yellow** and **white**? They are **mittens**

What animal goes meow? It's a cat

What animal goes woof? It's a dog

What animal goes tweet? It's a bird

What animal goes splash? It's a fish

What animal goes squeak? It's a hamster

What animals goes hop-hop? It's a rabbit

What animal goes croak? It's a tortoise

What animal goes moo? It's a cow

Thirsty! Let's give him some...

fruit/ sandwiches/ eggs/ sausages/ sweets
